Requirements & Guidelines

Requirements:

- **Two-Year Associates Degree Scholarship: Must have a high school diploma or GED**
- **Two-Year Bachelor's Degree Scholarship: Must have a high school diploma or GED**

Guidelines:

1. The award will be for two (2) academic years and will be applied directly to the student's tuition.
2. All applications, scholarship essays, and recommendations must be sent by no later than 11:59 p.m. Friday, June 18th, 2010. The selection process will begin on Tuesday, June 22nd and will conclude prior to July 1st. Applications and Essays will be evaluated by Columbia Southern University along with the Executive Committee of the AFCA. Notifications will follow with the Scholarship Award Presentation occurring during the 2010 Fire Service Leadership Conference in Glendale Arizona. **Applications and essays can be sent either by mail or email.**
3. The individuals who are selected must maintain a 3.5 overall GPA, remain in good standing, and remain enrolled in a CSU degree program to maintain eligibility for the scholarship. Once an individual has completed two academic years, the scholarship ceases. All remaining funds of the scholarship not used by the student will revert to CSU.
4. Recipients of the award may reapply for the scholarship. No student may receive the scholarship more than twice.
